Smart Telecom to supply NGN to SAP and Galway County Council

Smart Telecom has announced it has recently signed agreements with both SAP and Galway County Council to provide them with its Next Generation Network (NGN) which comprises fibre network, unbundled exchanges, licenced microwave access, network management and processes. Both contracts are set to run for an initial 24 and 36 months respectively with an estimated value of €235k. These are the first in a series of customer announcements within the corporate and public sector following Smart Telecom's €90m revamp, which included €65m in refinancing and the addition of the T50 network in Dublin. Smart Telecom is now focused on data, broadband and VoIP services to the corporate, SME and residential sectors.
